### **Called to order:** 9:18 pm

This was a special meeting held by teleconference for State Presidents, WPSL, NPSL. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the direction for the USASA Select Program and the proposal for the Region IV Select program.

The National Association has decided to go to a "Camp" format for the Select program next year. There has been an informal presentation; the formal presentation will be in April. The details are currently being worked out.

For this year, other regions still want to get together and play a Select tournament. Region IV doesn't seem to want to do this because of cost and travel time. Geir and Bill got together to try to come up with an idea that would work for Region IV. They presented a proposal for a Region IV Select Camp.

The Select Camp would be held at the San Diego Olympic training center in Chula Vista, June 15-17. It will need to be a manageable size, which is anticipated to be about 48 players. The cost of the Camp will be about \$225 per player. This would include lodging and food.

The last time Region IV tried a camp format, States did not necessarily send the best players to the Select Camp. To make this work, we must get the right players to the Camp. States will be asked to supply a number of players in proportion to the State size. In addition to the States delegating players to attend, the Region Select coaches will go out scouting at National Cups games and other events and recommend players to attend.
